Bioident Technologies opens in Menlo Park

Bioident Technologies Inc. opened its U.S. headquarters in Menlo Park, the company said Monday.

Privately-held Bioident, which develops printed semiconductor-based photonic lab-on-a-chip products for life sciences, is a subsidiary of Austria-based Nanoident Technologies AG.

The newly-launched U.S. venture also named Wasiq Bokhari as chief executive.

The company said Bokhari has extensive entrepreneurial experience in adoption and commercialization of emerging materials and nanotechnology, and is a co-founder and managing partner of Menlo Park-based Quantum Insight, where he works with Fortune 500 and early-stage companies in the areas of life sciences, energy and semiconductor applications.
